Hi! Thanks for downloading the Butterfly Quiet Book Template from jocelynandjason.blogspot.com.


A few important notes:

- Some of the detachable pieces in this quiet book (such as the caterpillar body pieces and the little butterflies on ribbons) are double layered. Rather than cutting the two copies of the shape out of the felt and then sewing them together, I found it easier to cut one copy out and sew it directly to the big sheet of felt. I then cut that double-layered piece out of the sheet of felt.
- These templates are for personal use only. That means you cannot sell them or use them to create items for sale.




Cut 52 border pieces,

(Cut 3)




Caterpillar
(for cocoon)




Caterpillar

To make each of the caterpillar body pieces double-layered with velcro on the back, I found it easiest to first sew the piece of velcro to the main felt sheet. I then cut the caterpillar body piece circle and sewed it to the felt sheet where the velcro was. Finally, I cut the whole thing out, resulting in a double layered body piece with velcro on the back.

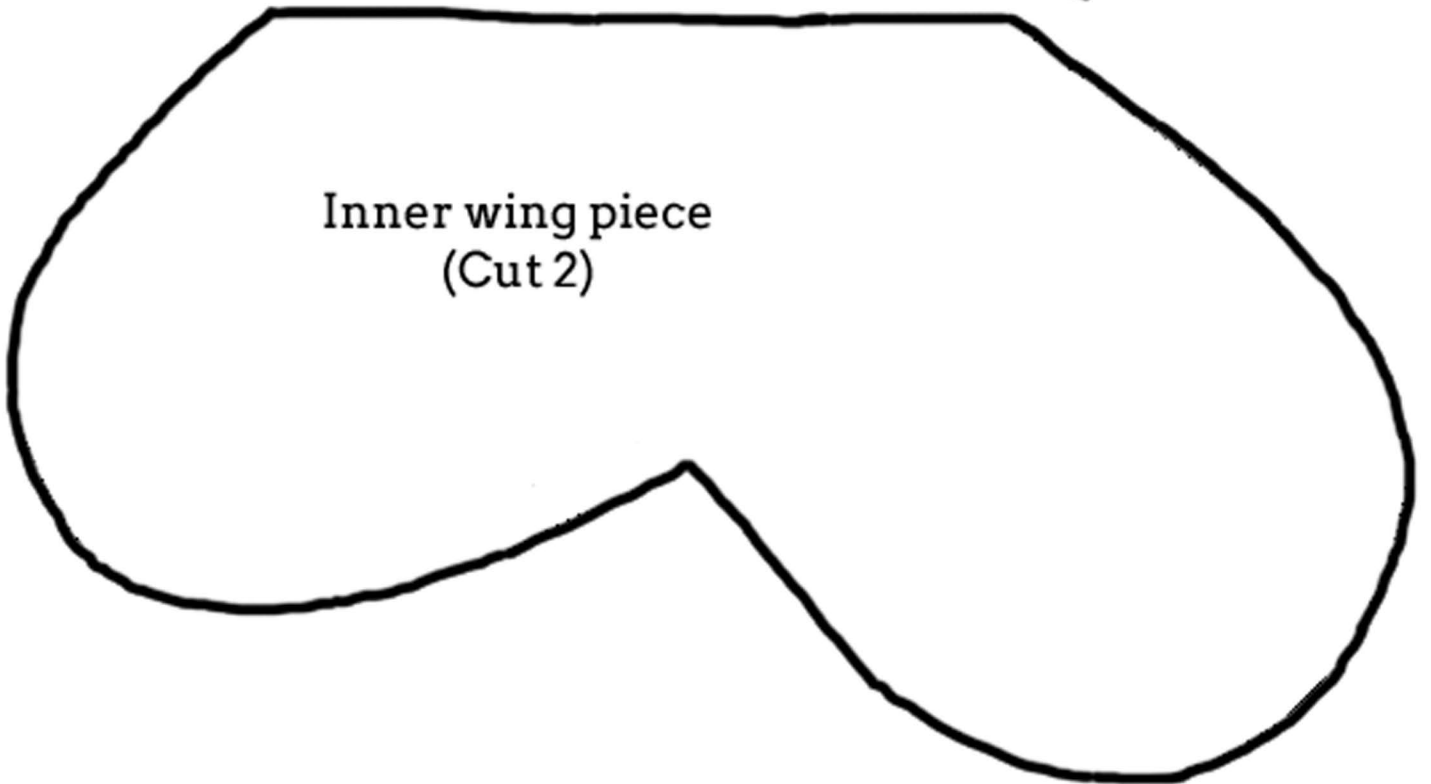
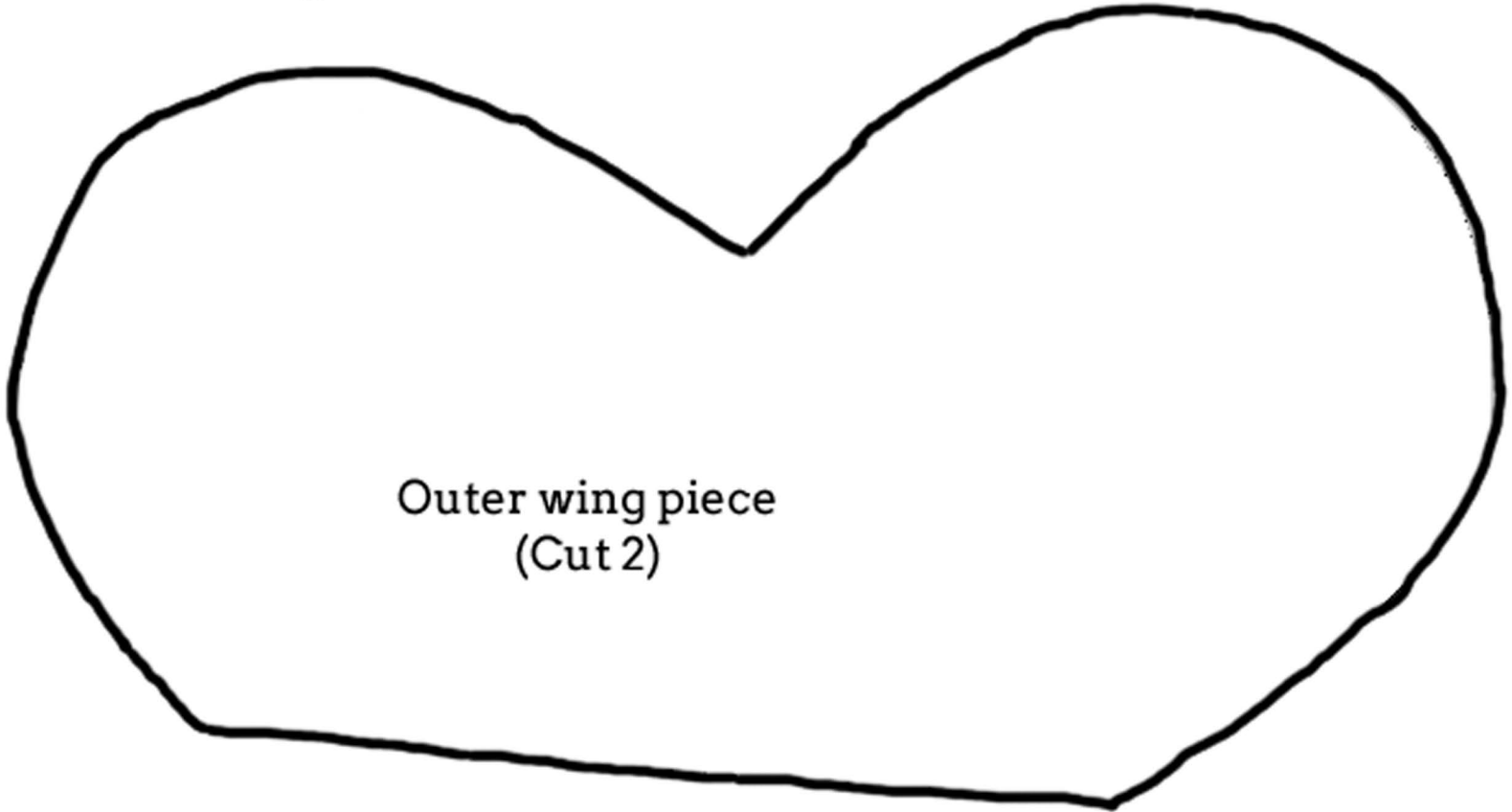
Grass piece 1

Connect paper (with tape or glue) to Grass piece 2 paper at dotted lines, before you cut the felt

The little butterflies and butterfly bodies are too small to be sewn by a machine; I hand-sewed them. Also, they are attached to the page by a ribbon. One end of the ribbon is sewn under the grass piece, and the other end of the ribbon is in between the two layers of the butterfly.

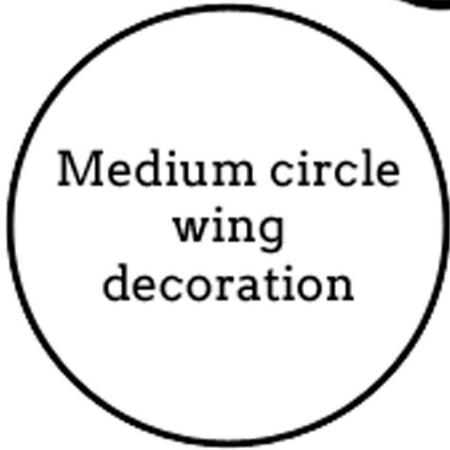
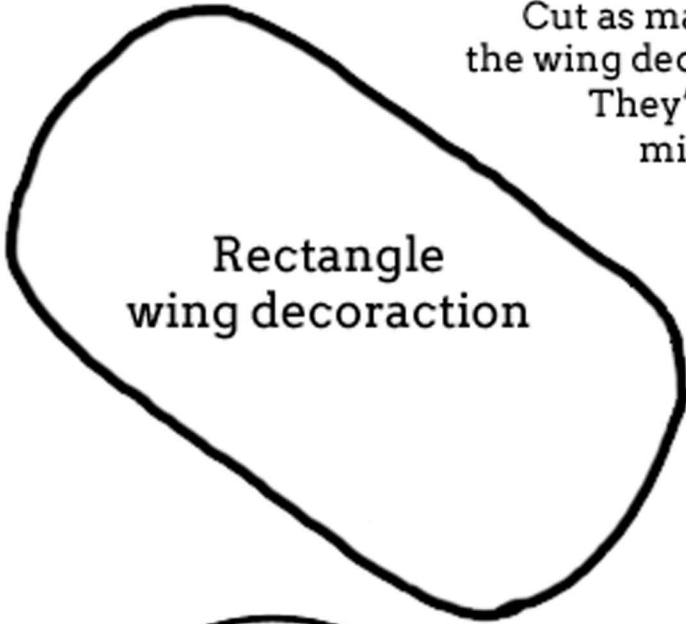

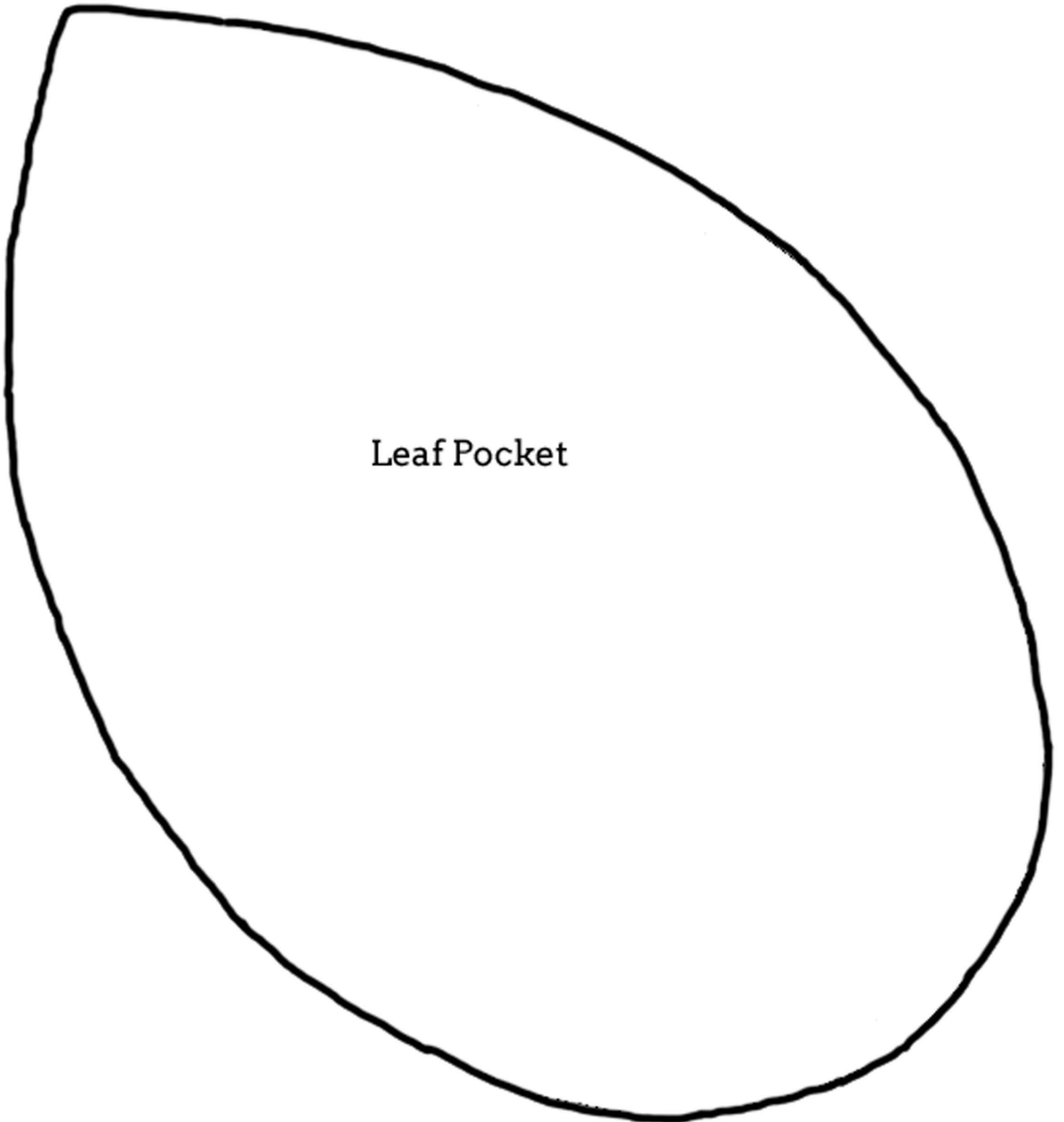
